Weekly Progress Report from 28th Feb to 4th March 2022

Activity 1	Ten students are undergoing one-month online certificate course on “Digital Marketing” being organized by NAHEP, IDP-SKUAST Kashmir. The objective of the course is to focus on the key skills for search Engine optimization and Google Analytics, To provide students with exposure to workplace opportunities and To assist them to evaluate future employment options. The course commenced on 17 th February 2022. The amount to be paid for the registration of the students shall be Rs. 4000 i.e @ Rs. 400/student as registration fee.
Activity 2	Ms. Tanya (J-18-Biotech-213), Final year student of B.Tech. Biotechnology, SKUAST -Jammu has been selected and enrolled for four-month internship in the area of Bioinformatics at IHBT (CSIR), Palampur along with sanctioning fee amounting to Rs.10,000/-plus 18% GST under NAHEP-IDP, Project.
Activity 3	The Directorate of Research SKUAST-Jammu is organizing one day Seed Conference on 09/03/2022 with the theme “ Start-ups in Seed Production ” where eminent seeds scientists of the country have been invited to deliver lectures. Dr. Sanjay Kumar, Director ICAR, IISS, Mau UP and Dr. G.P Singh Director ICAR, IIV&BR Karnal shall be the expert speakers. 33 students (UG/PG) of Agriculture stream have shown their interest to join the seed conference and all the aspirants are being nominated under NAHEP, IDP SKUAST-Jammu to attend the same.
Activity 4	NAHEP-IDP, SKUAST – Jammu is going to start Remedial cum JRF classes from 04-03-2022 for the students of Faculty of Agriculture, Faculty of Veterinary Sciences & Animal Husbandry and School of Biotechnology in order to improve their academic proficiency as well as to make them professionally competent. An amount of Rs. 1, 40,000/- shall have to be paid as remuneration to the identified teachers and PG/Ph.D scholars as per IDP guidelines for delivering the lectures.
