Activity 1	<p>NAHEP-IDP SKUAST-J, conducted an expert lecture in virtual mode on the topic “Responsible Use of Antimicrobials: Where are we and where are we going to?” for the students of Faculty of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry of SKUAST-J, R.S Pura on August 5, 2022 The keynote talk was given by Dr. Herman Barkema, Chair, Infectious Diseases of Dairy Cattle, University of Calgary Faculty of Veterinary Medicine’s (UCM), Canada. A total of 70 students attended the programme.</p>

Activity 3	United Phosphorous Limited (UPL), Samba, UT of J&K, is providing an opportunity to undergraduates B.Sc. The NAHEP IDP team of SKUAST-Jammu suggested the following points to be included in the draft note.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The J&K bank shall facilitate SKUAST-J students for internships and will also manage honorary guest lectures to acquaint university students about avenues in banking sector. - The J&K bank shall extend loans to the students who have University recommendation for taking up entrepreneurship / agri start-ups on liberal rate of interest at par with Kisan Credit Cards holders. - Priority/ preference shall be given by J&K bank to SKUAST-J students in job placement. <p>The J&K bank shall be a meaningful sponsor of different Research & Academic related programmes of the university viz. Workshops, Conferences, Seminars, Brainstorming sessions etc.</p>
Activity 6	<p>Dr. Tilak Raj Sharma, Deputy Director General (Crop Science), ICAR New Delhi, and Dr. Sunil Chandra Dubey, ADG (Plant Protection & Biosafety), ICAR New Delhi, visited IDP building housing different units at main campus of SKUAST-J at Chatha viz: Smart classroom, Placement cell, IIC cell, Language lab on September 8, 2022 and also had an interaction with the core team of IDP SKUAST-Jammu.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;">   </div>
